

37 Dead After Drinking Toxic Liquor In Tamil Nadu, MK Stalin Cracks Down

At least 68 others, who reportedly consumed the toxic liquor over the past few days, have been hospitalised.

Eighteen of them have been shifted to JIPMER in Puducherry and six to the Medical College and Hospital in Salem.

Chennai: Thirty-seven people have died after consuming toxic liquor in Tamil Nadu's Kallakurichi district, around 250 km from state capital Chennai. At least 55 others, who reportedly consumed the toxic liquor over the past few days, have been hospitalised. Eighteen of them have been shifted to JIPMER in Puducherry and six to the Medical College and Hospital in Salem.

Many of these victims were from Karunapuram area. A woman who lost her son said, "He complained of severe stomach ache and difficulty to open his eyes. He said he had consumed arrack. Initially, the hospital refused to admit him, saying he's drunk. The state government should shut all liquor shops." Another mother said, "My son suffered excruciating stomach pain. He could neither see nor hear. This shouldn't happen to anyone. Stop selling liquor."

Police have arrested a suspected bootlegger and detained two others. Confirming that these deaths were caused due to consumption of toxic liquor, a senior police

officer told NDTV, "We are investigating what exactly they consumed. We have taken three people into custody. At least three of the four people who died had consumed liquor supplied by private people, not procured from the government-run liquor shops." In a statement, the state government said 26 people had taken arrack from packets and added that forensic investigation had confirmed the presence of poisonous methanol. The state government has suspended district police chief Samay Singh Meena and appointed Rajat Chaturvedi in his place. Collector Sravan Kumar Jatavath has been replaced by MS Prasanth. A Deputy Superintendent of Police-rank officer of prohibition enforcement wing, three inspectors and as many sub-inspectors were suspended. The state government also transferred the probe into the toxic liquor tragedy to CB-CID. Chief Minister MK Stalin said in a post



on X that he is shocked and pained about the loss of lives. "The accused have been arrested. Action has been taken against officials who failed to prevent this. We will crack down with an iron hand. If public complain about such perpetrators, action would be taken." He has asked two ministers, including Health Minister Ma Subramaniam, to rush to Kallakurichi and ensure every

possible medical help to the affected people.

The Chief Minister has announced an inquiry by Justice (retired) B Gokuldas, a retired judge of Madras High Court. A compensation of ₹ 10 lakh will be provided to the families of each of the victims. Mr Stalin had ordered the arrest of illegal liquor brewers, methanol seller and destruction of methanol. Disturbing reports started emerging yesterday after three people died in different locations over the past three days.

Despite a buzz that the deaths may have been caused by toxic liquor, District Collector Sravan Kumar Jatavath initially denied such reports. "These deaths have happened over three days. One of them was a teetotaler and one of them had a stomach problem. No one died in the hospital, and none came in an inebriated condition. In the commotion, someone said illicit liquor and

it spread. We are investigating," he had said. This tragedy is being seen as a huge failure by intelligence agencies and the prohibition enforcement wing. Last year, too, 22 people died in Tamil Nadu after consuming methanol. AIADMK chief and Leader of Opposition in the Assembly Edappadi K Palaniswami slammed the ruling DMK for and said the state government failed to curb the toxic liquor problem even after he pointed out. "I urge Chief Minister M K Stalin to take stringent action to curb toxic liquor instead of word play like last time, when they called it methanol and not toxic liquor." State BJP chief K Annamalai said DMK had not "learnt its lesson" after 22 deaths due to consumption of toxic liquor last year. Governor R N Ravi, whose tenure has seen several face-offs between the ruling party and the Raj Bhavan, posted on X, "This reflects continuing lapses in preventing production and consumption of illicit liquor. It is a matter of serious concern."

PM Modi's Big Gift to Kashi: An Improved Airport With New Terminal Building, Extended Runway And More

New Delhi: In the first full meeting since the portfolio allocation, the Union Cabinet led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved a big gift for Varanasi. The Airports Authority of India's proposal for the development of Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport, Varanasi including the construction of a new terminal building, apron extension, runway extension, parallel taxi track and allied works has been given a go ahead on Wednesday. Varanasi, traditionally known as Kashi, holds a very special place in the heart of PM Modi. He has been elected as a Lok Sabha MP from there in 2014, 2019 and 2024. After winning all the three terms, Modi had been elected to the office of the Prime Minister of India. "The estimated financial outgo will be Rs 2869.65 crore for enhancing the passenger handling capacity of the airport to 9.9 million passengers per annum (MPPA) from the existing 3.9 MPPA. The New Terminal Building, which encompasses an area of 75,000 sqm, is designed for a capacity of 6 MPPA and for handling 5000 Peak Hour Passengers (PHP). It is designed to offer a glimpse of the vast cultural heritage of the city," the government said in its official brief. It further added, "The proposal includes extending the runway to dimensions 4075m x 45m and constructing a new Apron to park 20 aircraft. Varanasi airport will be developed as a green airport with the primary objective of ensuring environmental sustainability through energy optimisation, waste recycling, carbon footprint reduction, solar energy utilisation, and incorporation of natural daylighting, alongside other sustainable measures throughout the planning, development, and operational stages." Very recently, PM Modi distributed the 17th instalment of PM Kisan Samman Nidhi during a function in Kashi. Through this, 9.3 crore farmers received DBT into their accounts at an estimated cost of Rs 20,000 crore. The glorious town of Kashi has seen a major facelift ever since Modi became its public representative a decade ago. Right from the redevelopment of the Kashi Vishwanath Temple corridor to making a rudraksh meditation centre, Modi, just earlier this year in February, also laid the foundation stone for multiple development projects worth more than Rs 13,000 crore in Varanasi.



Bihar deputy chief minister claims Tejashwi aide linked to NEET paper leak

Bihar deputy chief minister Vijay Kumar Sinha claimed that RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav's aide Preetam Kumar was linked to the alleged paper leaks and malpractices of the NEET exam row.

Bihar. Deputy Chief Minister Vijay Kumar Sinha on Thursday claimed that Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) leader Tejashwi Yadav's aide was linked to the alleged paper leaks and the malpractices of the NEET-UG 2024 row.

At a press briefing, Sinha claimed that Tejashwi Yadav's aide Preetam Kumar called an employee of the Bihar Road Construction Department (RCD) to book a room for Sikandar Prasad Yadavendu, an engineer who earlier revealed an alleged involvement of a 'Mantri Ji' in the entrance exam row.

Sikandar Prasad Yadavendu claimed he recommended the stay of his nephew Anurag Yadav, a NEET aspirant, his mother and other accomplices at a government bungalow in



Patna. Anurag Yadav is currently behind bars in connection with the exam irregularities.

Vijay Kumar Sinha claimed he conducted a departmental inquiry into the matter, and learnt that Preetam Kumar called the RCD

staffer named Pradeep to book a room at the guest house of Bihar NHAI on May 1 - four days before the examination took place across the country. The Bihar Deputy Chief Minister alleged there were call details of Preetam Kumar calling Pradeep.

"I demand a high level inquiry into this matter. They are out of power, but want to play with the future of lakhs of candidates," Sinha said.

He further stated that he had suspended three employees of the Road Construction Department, including Pradeep, in connection with the room booking. However, the Bihar NHAI junked the reports of the accused staying at their guest house, mentioning in a statement that it "does not

have any guest house facility in Patna." Some sections of the press have reported that the accused related to the NEET paper leak case stayed at NHAI guest house in Patna. NHAI would like to clarify that NHAI does not have any guest house facility in Patna," the statement added. In his confession letter, Sikandar Prasad Yadavendu wrote that his nephew informed him about getting desired results "as promised earlier". The engineer also stated that he was in touch with a racket, which excelled in leaking question papers for aspirants of NEET, UPSC and other examinations. Yadavendu also claimed he made logistical arrangements for other candidates, namely Ayush Raj, Shivanandan Kumar, Abhishek Kumar, Anurag Yadav and Anurag's mother Reena. Meanwhile, earlier in the day, in his confession letter, Anurag Yadav admitted that the leaked question paper provided to him matched the actual exam question paper.
